Gabi is working for an employer who hasn't paid her for several weeks or underpays her, saying he'll pay her when the orders are shipped. Gabi has worked for him for almost a year, from January 1, 2022, to November 1, 2022.

She works 12 hours a day, Monday through Friday, but sometimes stays late or works weekends to get orders out. They promise her \$350 a week. But in reality, she's never received \$350; instead, her pay varies: \$200 one week, \$100 the next, and then \$400 the following week. She keeps track of all the money they owe her. She doesn't want to work for such unstable wages anymore.

It's been too long and she wants to do something about it. She knows several other people who are unhappy. She still works at the factory as a trimmer, so she has access to all the labels and tickets that are produced.
