STEP 5: STATE FUND



If your employer did not show up during the entire process or does not have the money to pay what is owed. You can collect your stolen wages through the State Fund!



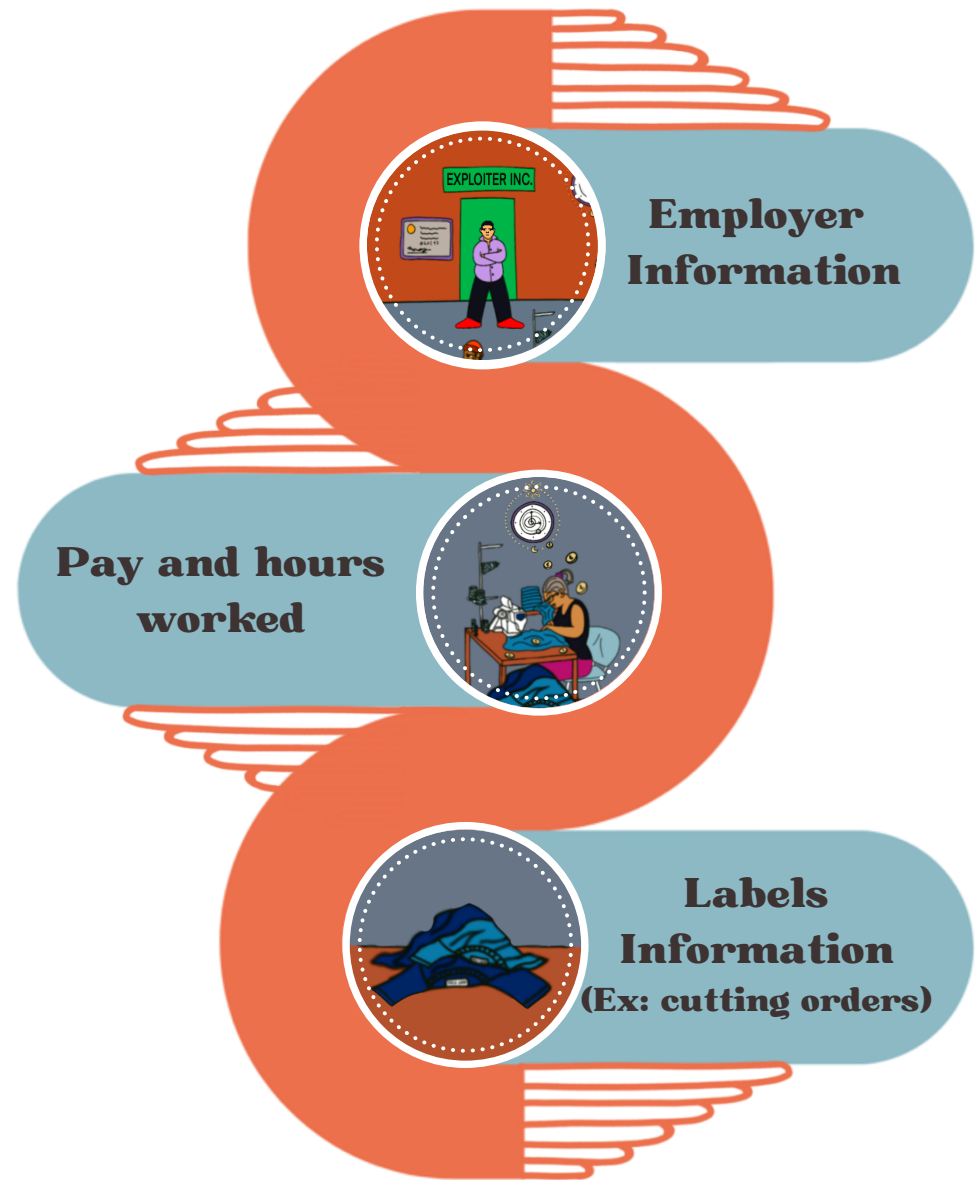
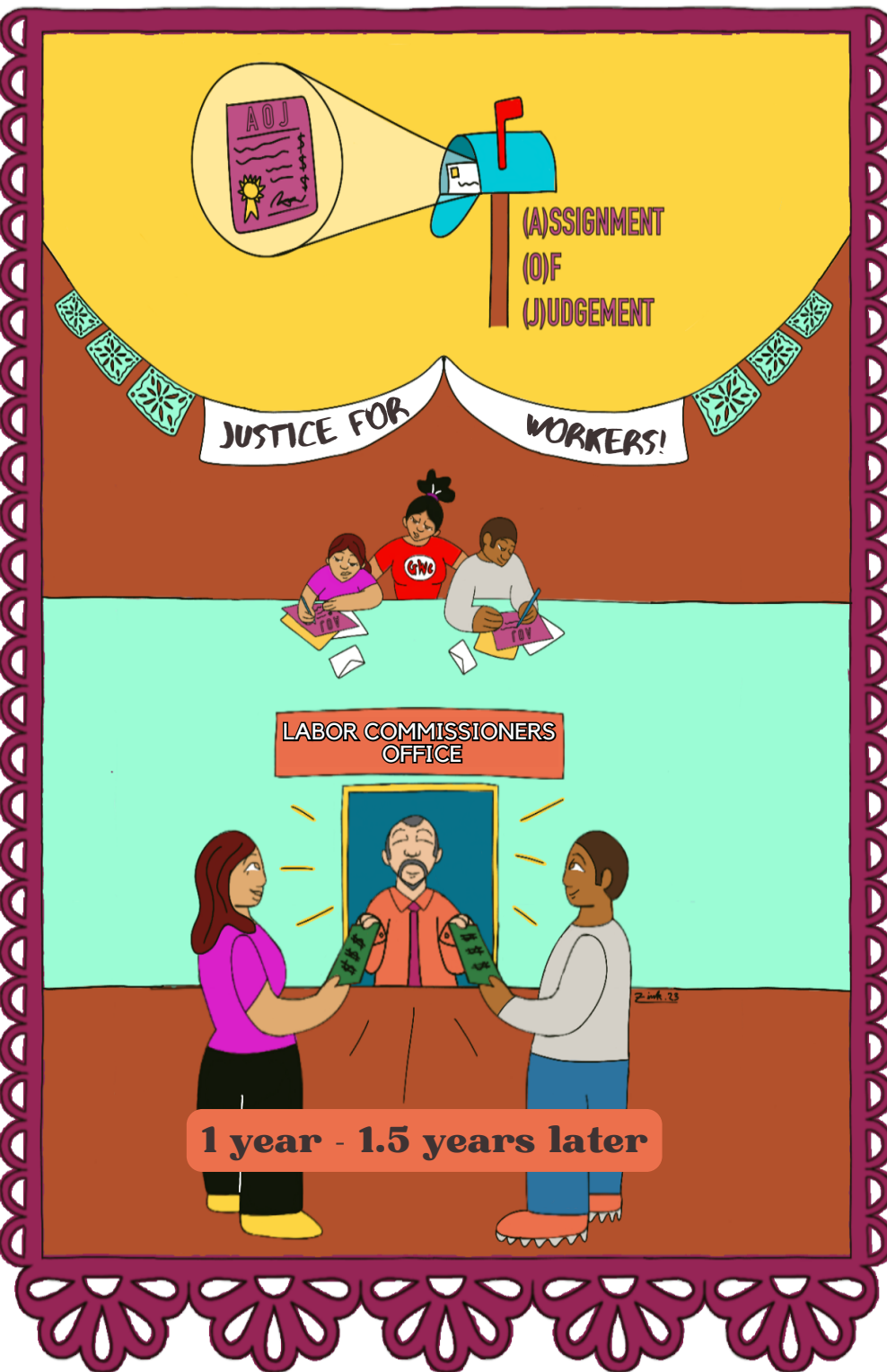
What is the fund?
The State Fund was created for when employers cannot pay an employee's stolen wages

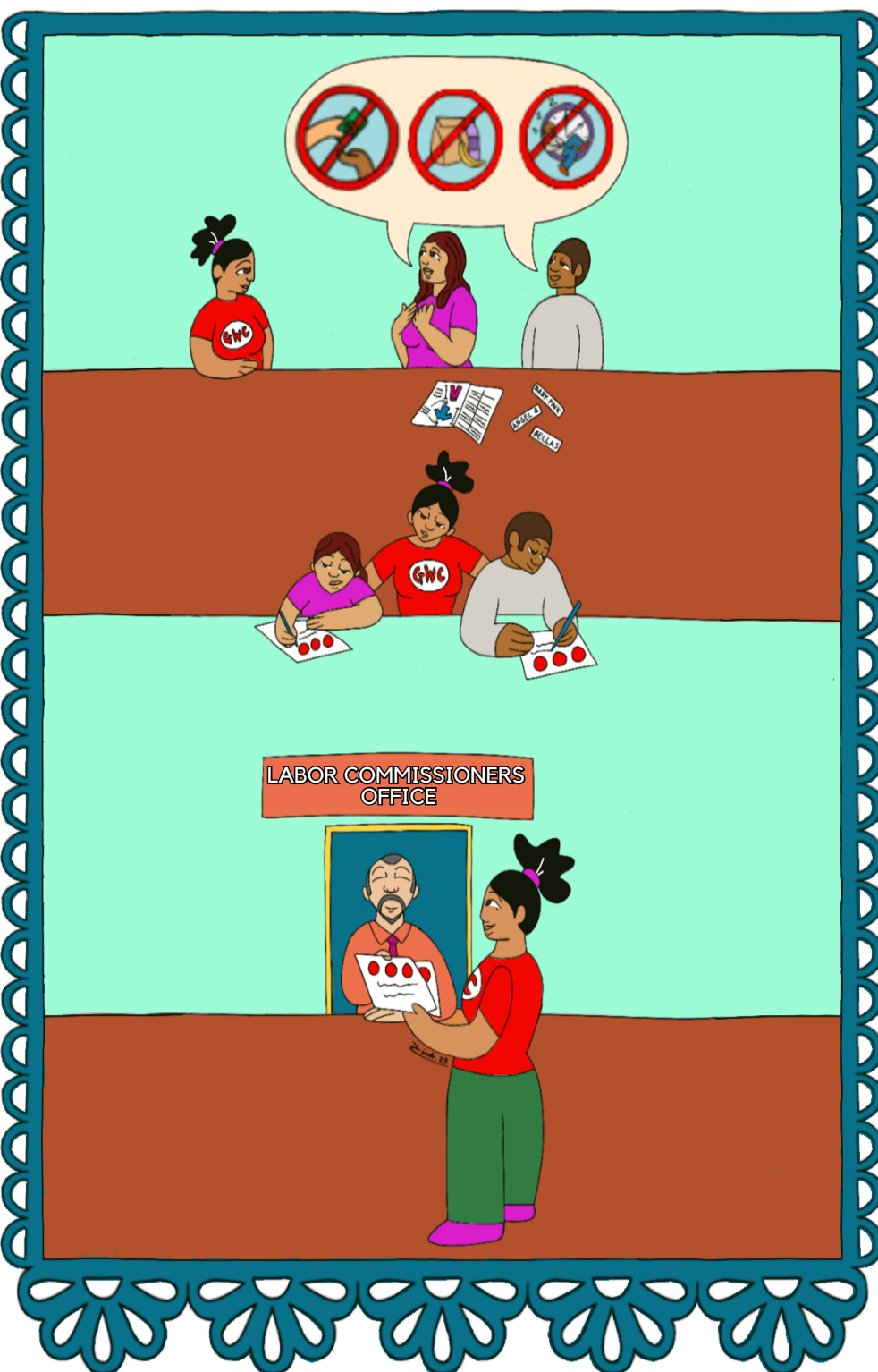
What do I need to collect my money from the state fund?

STEP 1: COLLECT INFORMATION / EVIDENCE

STEP 4: HEARING



If an agreement is not reached, you attend a hearing to prove your case. Our job is to prove that employer owes you wages.

4 months - 1 year later



How do we prepare you for a hearing?

- Review evidence
- Practice testimony

After a Hearing

You receive an ODA (the decision and the amount you are owed by your employer). This is where workers can appeal a decision made.

6 months - 1 year later

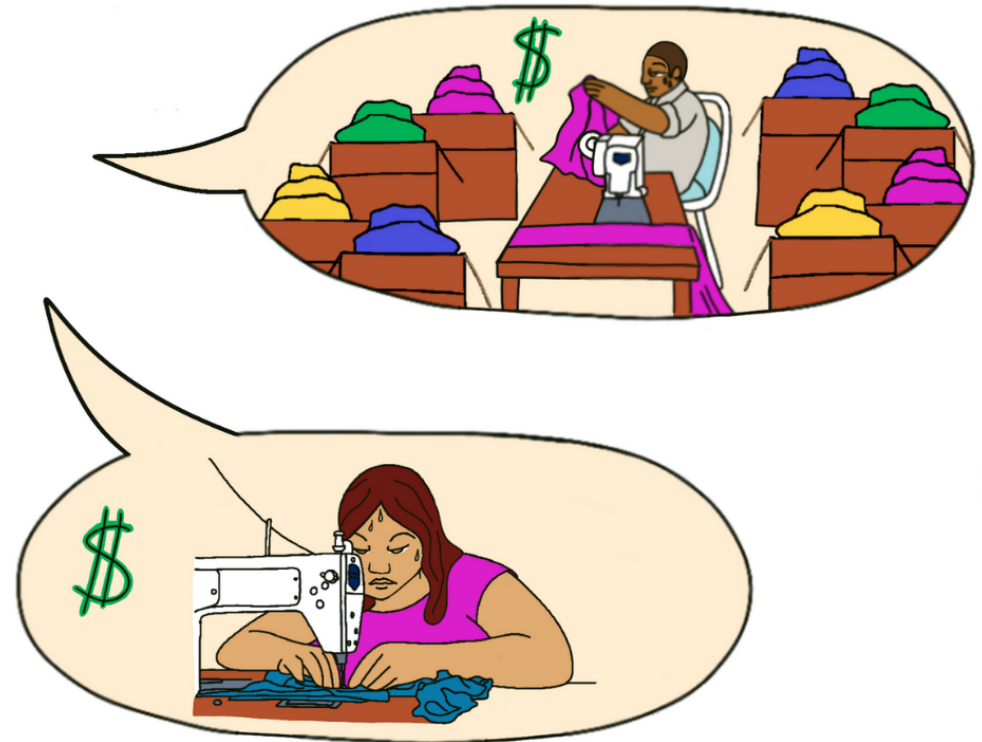


GWC will represent workers through the entirety of the wage claim.
